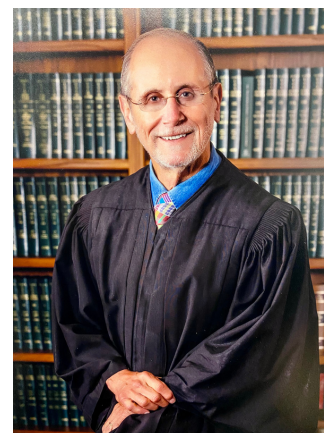

**What do you love most about the library?**  
I enjoy the genealogical section.

**What is your favorite book?**  
There are several favorites:

*All The King's Men* by Robert Penn Warren. This novel is based upon the political career of Huey P. Long. I have read it at least three times. History and politics are two favorite interest of mine.

*Grapes of Wrath* by John Steinbeck. Another historical novel about the Joads and the Great Depression, the Dust Bowl, the *Okies* and their difficulties in life. They retained their humanity in the midst of their difficult lives. A touching ending.

*A Marginal Jew, Rethinking the Historical Jesus, Volumes One through Five* by John P. Meier. These five volumes gave me an appreciation of who Jesus of Nazareth was. Meier writes as an historian, not a theologian and arrives at some conclusions that do not conform to orthodox, theological interpretations of his life and ministry. Interesting enough, each volume received an Imprimatur from the dioceses ( New York, New York; Hartford, CT.) in which he was living and teaching at the time he wrote each.
