Message from Library Director

Greetings for 2022! I'm sorry this message is a month later than normal, but we can admit that 2020 and 2021 were somewhat abnormal. On behalf of the library board members and staff, we are happy to say we are open with full services. Covid knocked us for a loop for the last two years, but it was Hurricane Ida that prevented us from opening all library branches in the last quarter of 2021. Hurricane Ida struck on August 29, 2021 devastating this parish. In spite of this category 4 hurricane causing devastation, the library opened two branches with full services 17 days later.



By October 1, 2021 six branches were open. The staff were eager to open libraries because they knew people needed computers, copy machines, and faxing services. Also, the libraries became places of rest and provided air conditioning for many people. The libraries became hubs for FEMA, the Small Business Association, and the National Guard who administered vaccines. People used the libraries as a workplace and parents soon became regulars at story times. The staff had FEMA and insurance company phone numbers memorized because of excessive times dialed. Along with helping the community, four staff members lost their homes, three were displaced from apartments, and two retired.

Three branches did sustain damage: the Main Library, Bourg and Dularge Branches; the six other branches had minor damages. The Main Library and Dularge Branch are open, but damage is visible. The Main Library had to be mitigated for mold removal, but the air quality has been tested numerous times and there is safe air quality. Remodeling is progressing with damaged carpet, ceiling tiles, window and dry wall repair. The Dularge Branch has roof and ceiling damage. The Bourg Branch sustained the most damage and will not reopen. The branch is not reopening because a regional branch, consolidating Bourg, Chauvin, and Montegut, is being constructed.

The library continues to add new programs and provides regular activities. The Downtown Market is now housed at the Main Library on Tuesdays from 3 p.m. until dark. This is the market formerly at South Louisiana Feed and Seed. Vendors are being sought, contact the library for more information. The Creative Lab is open at the Main Library. Machines available are Glowforge Pro laser cutter, a Dremel 3D printer, Cricut cutting machines, Brother computerized sewing and serging machines, a laminator, light pads, press irons, and various handicrafts and tools. Staff is available to help you and classes are offered on each machine. Book discussion groups, story times, arts and craft classes are resuming. Battle of the Books is taking place in area schools and the "Witness To Change: Community Conversations on Coastal Impacts" has resumed. We welcome you to the library. We are implementing more programs and know Covid affects many things. We encourage masks and want you to feel comfortable in the facilities. We look forward to seeing you in 2022!




