Attendees can register on-site for a 10-minute pitch or editing session with an editor.

First Page American Idol: Attendees can bring the first page of a book draft or poem, it will be read aloud anonymously and then critiqued by a panel of 4 of our presenters. Registration opens at 12:30. Not all submissions will be read based on time constraints.



Maurice Carlos Ruffin

Maurice Carlos Ruffin will be this year's Keynote Speaker. His most recent book is *The American Daughters* (One World, 2024), which Publishers Weekly, in a starred review, called "a vibrant picture of antebellum New Orleans." He is also the author of the story collection *The Ones Who Don't Say They* Love You (One World, 2021), which was a New York Times Editors' Choice, a finalist for the Ernest J. Gaines Award for Literary Excellence, and longlisted for the Story Prize. His

first book, We Cast a Shadow (One World, 2019), was a finalist for the PEN/ Faulkner Award, the Dayton Literary Peace Prize, and the PEN America Open Book Prize. It was a New York Times Editors' Choice.

Other presenters include: Folwell Dunbar, Ernest Foundas, Abram Shalom Himelstein, Brandon Stouff, Adrian Van Young, Emma C. Wells, and Southern Writers' Workshop.





Fold3 Military Records

Fold3 is a genealogy database specializing in military records but also has other records unique to Native American and African American research. In this class, you will learn how to track your ancestors and find proof of their military services by searching service records, draft cards, pension lists, causality lists, and other sources. Additionally, the Fold3 database contains records such as the US Dawes Enrollment Cards 1898-1914 as well as publications about the US American Colonization Society 1792-1964.
