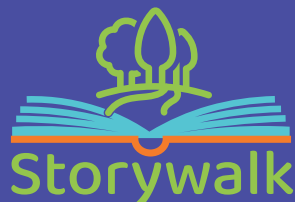

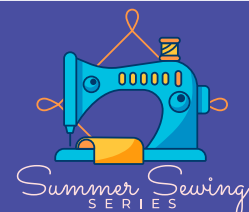

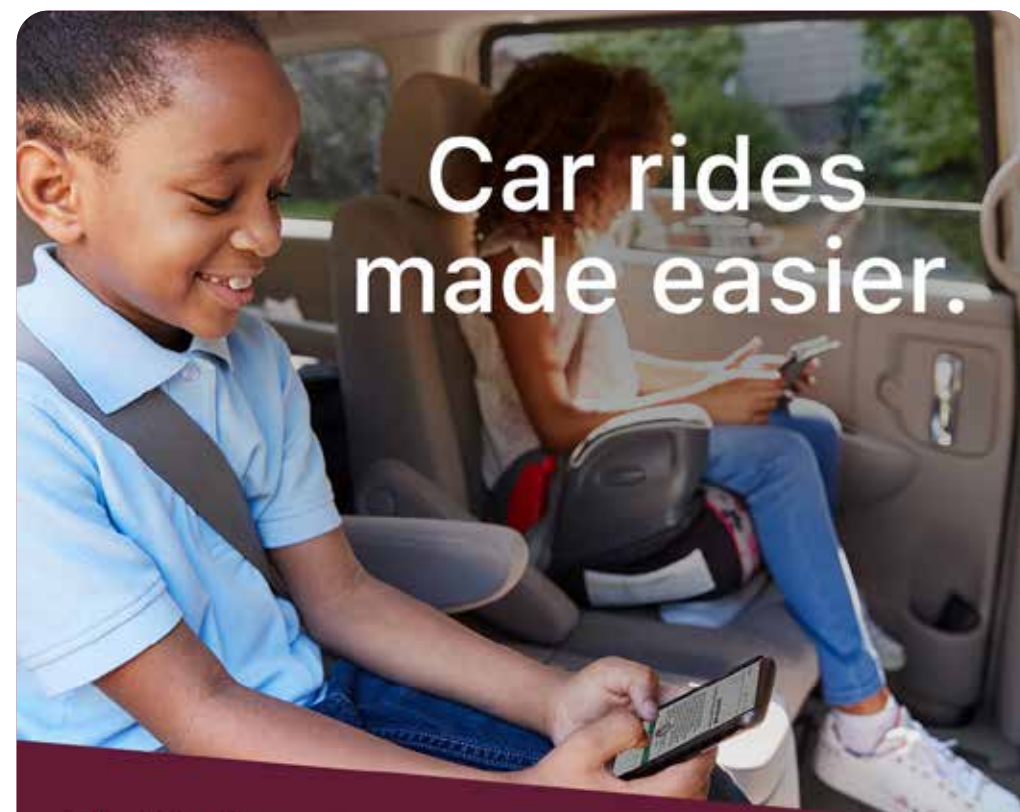

## GEOCACHING 101 June 21 @ 10 am (Main)

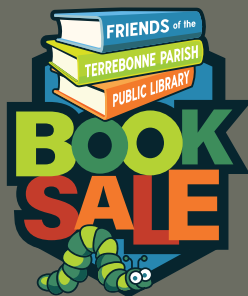

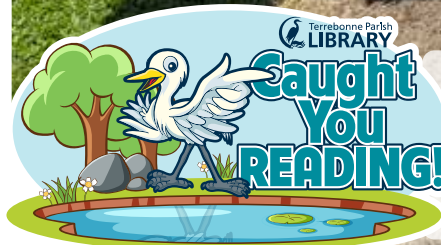
