## **TERREBONNE PARISH LIBRARY SYSTEM HONORED AS A TOP 5 LIBRARY IN THE NATION**

The Terrebonne Parish Library System has been named a 2025 recipient of the prestigious **National Medal for Museum and Library Service**, the nation's highest honor given to museums and libraries for community impact. Presented by the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS), the National Medal recognizes institutions that demonstrate extraordinary and innovative approaches to public service. Out of nearly **20,000** library systems across the United States, **only five libraries receive this distinction each year.** Terrebonne Parish Library is **the only parish in the state** to have won this distinguished award.

The Terrebonne Parish Library has been nominated five times for the National Medal. In 2025, the National Medal was awarded to the library. Why? Because of the connections that have developed with people, organizations, and partnerships. Why? Because of the service to the community during natural disasters, feeding people during times of need, and helping to enhance early childhood development. The list is long on why we won! We believe in going beyond the call of duty. We believe that non-readers deserve a library with services for them. We believe parish residents deserve the best in library service. The Terrebonne Parish Library is your community living room; your parish soul! We are extremely proud that this South Louisiana parish has been put on the map for something **OUTSTANDING!**


