

**Terrebonne Parish Library
Board of Control Minutes
April 15, 2026**

Chairwoman Mrs. Gwen Talbot called the Terrebonne Parish Library Board of Control regular meeting to order at 5:03 p.m. on April 15, 2026, at the Terrebonne Parish Main Library.

Members present were Judge Jude Fanguy, Mr. Jon Paul Olivier, Ms. Karen Schilling, and Ms. Devonna Simmons. Library Director Mary Cospier LeBoeuf was in attendance. A quorum was present. Assistant Director Tracy Guyan, Associate Director Rachel LeCompte, and Finance Manager Kimberly Smith were also present.

The Pledge of Allegiance and an invocation were recited.

Mr. Olivier moved to adopt the minutes for February 25, 2026. Ms. Simmons gave the second. The motion passed.

Mrs. LeBoeuf gave the director's report. All branches participated in Read Across America. She remarked on the success of a few larger activities: specifically, La Mariposa, Shire Fest, and the Orphan Train program. On April 21, 2026, patrons will be able to "checkout" passes to participating state parks. She also mentioned that the library had received a \$2,000 grant from Libraries Transform Communities; only two grants were awarded nationwide. The IMLS representative for Louisiana will be visiting the main library on May 28, 2026, since the library is a National Medal recipient.

Under old business, Mrs. LeBoeuf stated that demolition of the Bourg Branch should begin on May 4, 2026. The Montegut Branch will be demolished in the summer. The main library is still awaiting completion of the HVAC project.

Under new business, three bids were received for the upcoming renovation of the East Houma Branch.

- Foret Contracting Group, LLC - \$3,250,800
- Picceola Construction Co.- \$2,050,000
- Thompson Construction - \$2,835,500

Ms. Schilling moved to accept the low bid from Picceola Construction Co. for \$2,050,000 with the option of moving forward with the second lowest bid of \$2,835,500 if the first option falls through for any reason. Mr. Olivier gave the second. The motion passed.


Mr. Olivier moved to accept the January – March 2026 Financial Statement. Ms. Simmons gave the second. The motion passed.
