TECH TIPS FOR DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

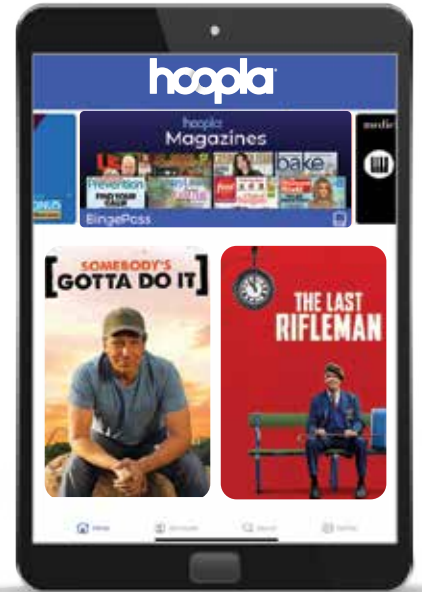
