



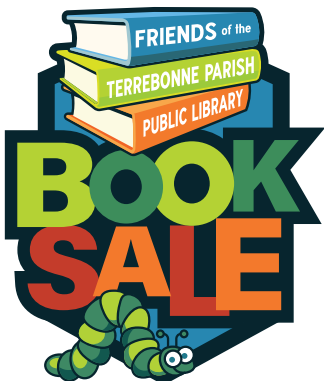
NATIONAL MEDAL CELEBRATION

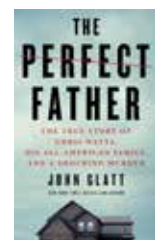
