Fans of all ages, join us for a super time at the Terrebonne Comic Con from 2 - 5 on Sunday, September 20, 2015!

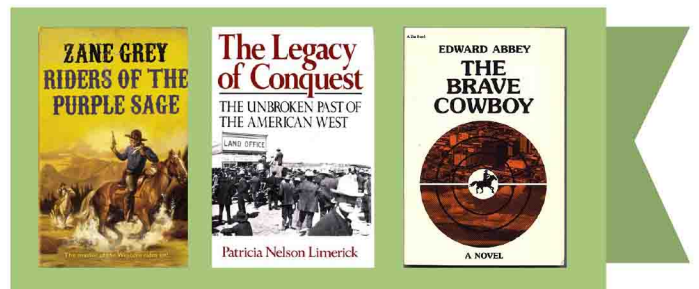
There will be costume contests, a comic book swap, gaming, comic book jeopardy, manga drawing sessions, story times, and more.

FRIENDS Inventory Reduction BOOK SALE — AUGUST 22 & 23 —

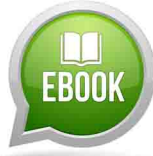

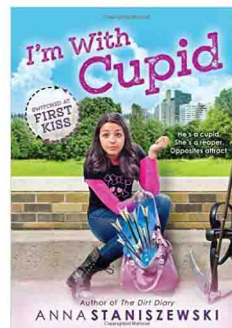
