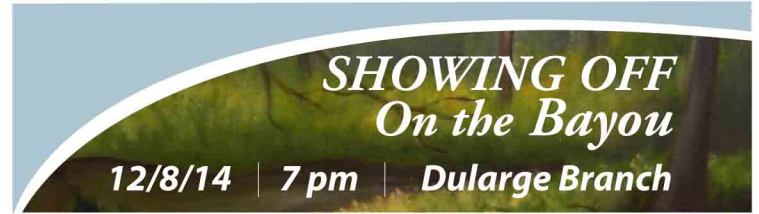

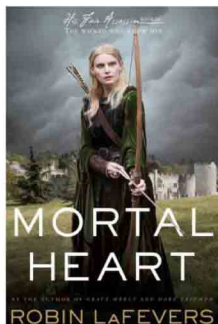
**Holiday Fun Workshop**

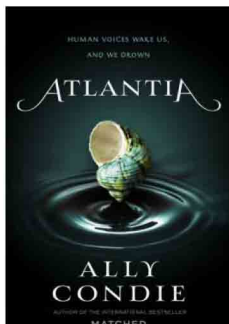

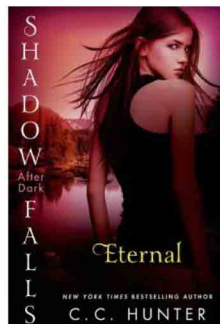
