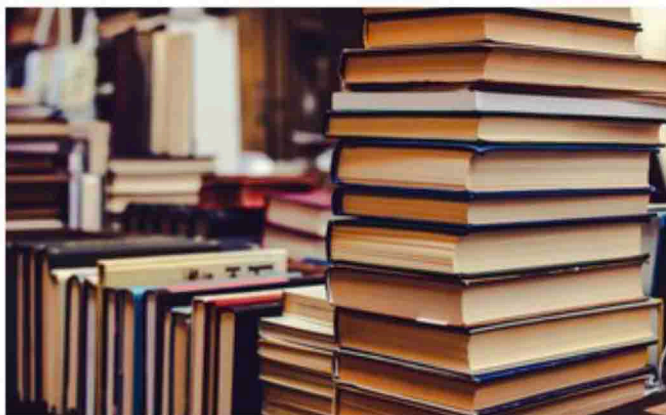
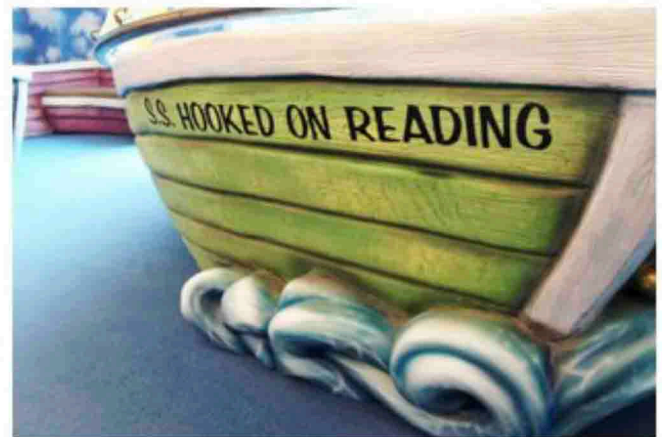

Recommended donations are \$3-\$5 a bag. Brown paper bags will be supplied. Past SRP t-shirts will also be sold for \$1 each.

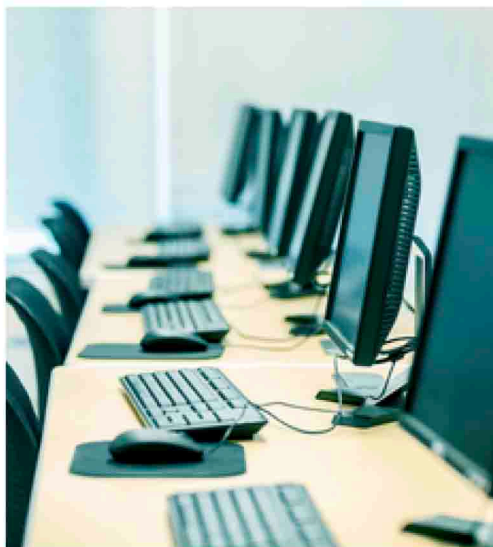


Book sale will be held at Main Library in the Arts and Crafts room any time during library hours.
