Determined to Rise: The Woman's Suffrage Movement in Louisiana

Determined to Rise: The Woman's Suffrage Movement in Louisiana is a traveling exhibit that celebrates the women's suffrage movement in Louisiana, honoring the 100th anniversary of the 19th Amendment.

Developed by the Centennial Women's Suffrage Project at Southeastern Louisiana University, with grant support from the Louisiana Endowment for the Humanities (LEH) Rebirth grant, the exhibit consists of eight panels depicting photos of Louisiana suffragists, a timeline of significant events, the movement from the African-American woman's perspective, laws that have changed since women gained the vote, and Louisiana women who have made their mark on history.

The exhibit will be at Main from January 5-January 15.

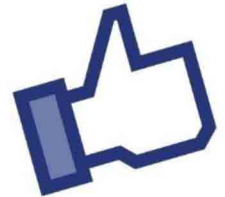
