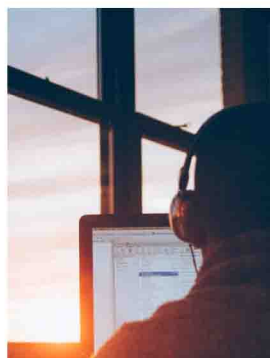
Can you tell us a few titles you are looking forward to reading in the New Year?
