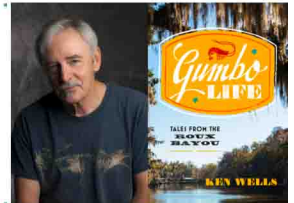

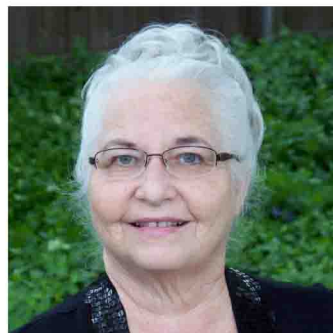

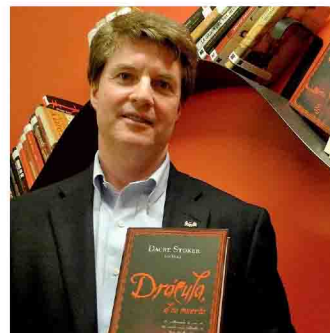
**Sheba Turk**

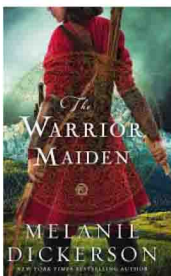

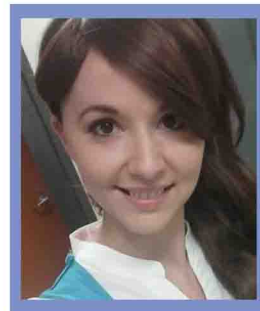

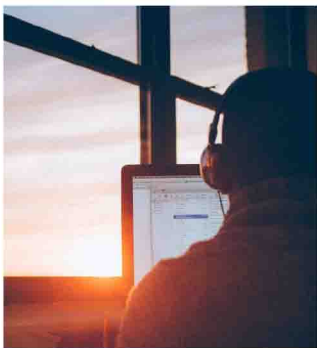
### What actor would you want to play you in a movie about your life?

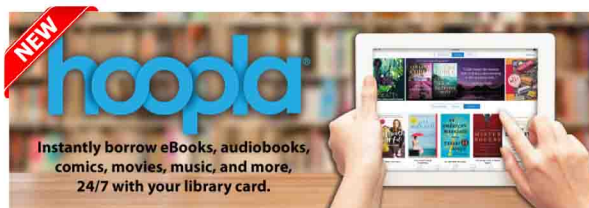
