Those who participate are encouraged to write 50,000 words, roughly the word count of an average novel, throughout the month. Focusing on process and deadline, the goal of NaNoWriMo is for writers to have a finished novel drafted by November 30.

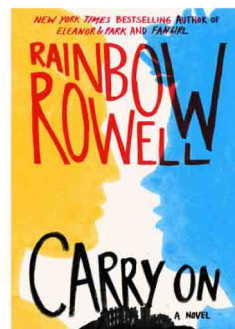

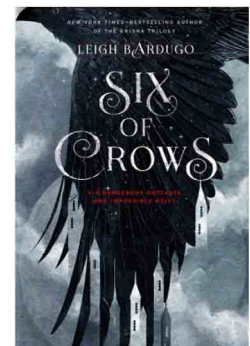

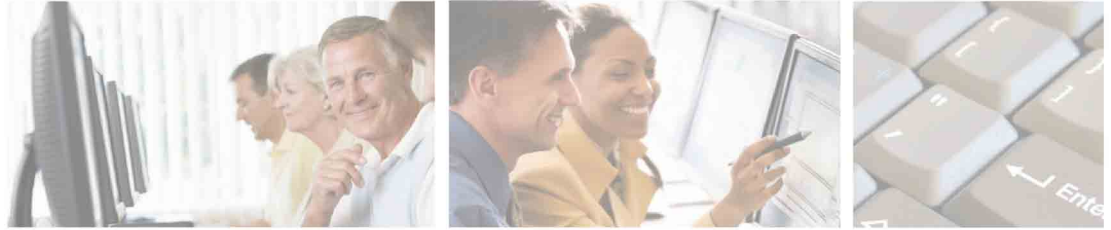
