Paying for Long-Term Care

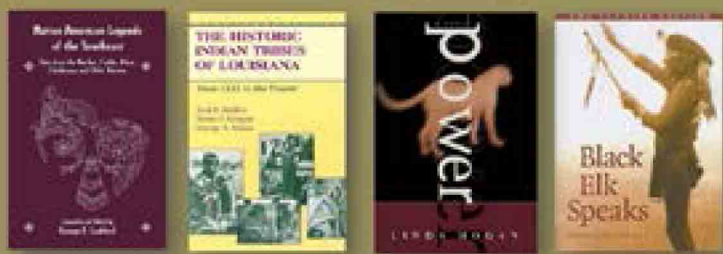
Thursday, 10/23 | 10:30 am | Main Library

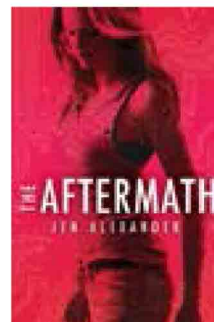

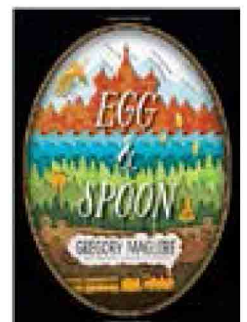
