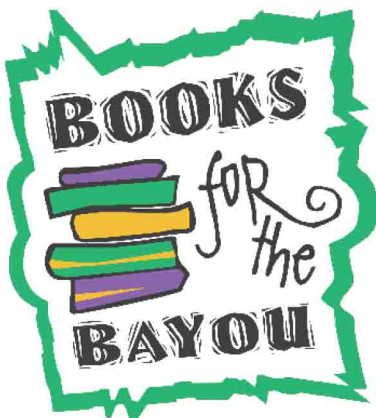

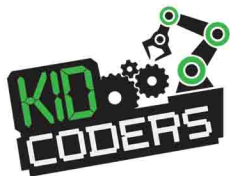

### How long have you worked for TPLS?

I have worked with the library system for 9 years.

### What do you love most about your job at the library?

I love recommending books and movies to patrons, but it's also great getting recommendations as well. One patron who was a big Stephen King fan was delighted when I introduced him to the works of H.P. Lovecraft.

### Spooky season is upon us! Can you tell us the names of some of your favorite scary books?

Richard Matheson's *Hell House* and *I am Legend* are great reads. Stephen King has so many. A few of my favorites are *The Shining*, *It*, and *Salem's Lot*. I also love the Gothic masterpieces of Edgar Allan Poe, including *Fall of the House of Usher*, *The Cask of Amontillado*, *The Tell-Tale Heart*, and *Masque of the Red Death*. H.P. Lovecraft's *The Colour Out of Space*, *Whisperer in Darkness*, and *The Shadow over Innsmouth* are anxiety made tangible.

### What do you like to do for fun when not at work?

I love science fiction, horror, and fantasy. I'm either reading books in these genres, watching them as movies, or playing them as video games. One of my all time favorite movies is *Dark City* with Kiefer Sutherland. The main character wakes up with no memories of himself but may actually be a serial killer. It is the perfect blend of science fiction and 1940's noir.
