STORY TELLING HOUR THURS, 9/17 @ 7pm

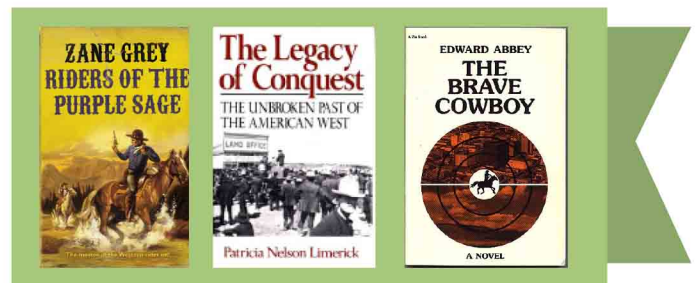
