TPL has partnered with local television station HTV to bring the adventures of Bae and Beb to a screen near you.

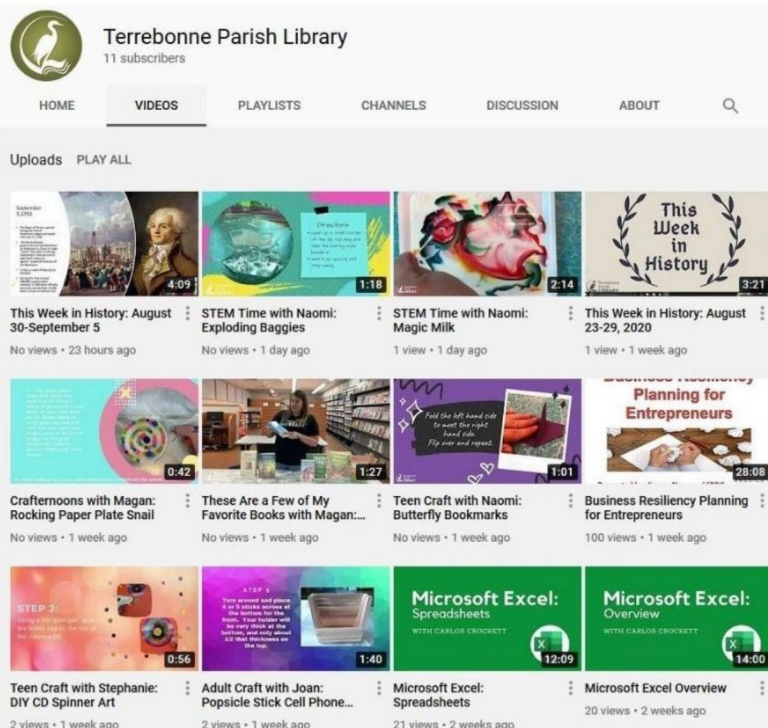

Did you know that Terrebonne Parish Library now has its very own Youtube channel?



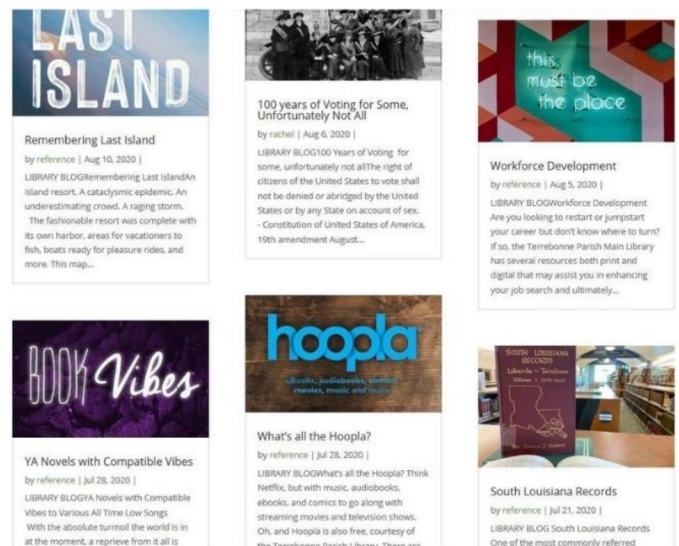
